

INSTRUCTIONS IN PREPERATION FOR ORAL SURGERY

You will be undergoing a surgical procedure. Surgery time is occasionally unpredictable. Please realize we do our best to stay on time, but there are occasions, however, where you may be asked to wait prior to your surgery.

Take your daily medications with a small sip of water the morning of surgery, as instructed by the doctor.

If you are given an antibiotic, please take as prescribed.

FOR PATIENTS WHO ARE SCHEDULED TO HAVE I.V. or ORAL SEDATION

DO NOT eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery. This includes water unless taking medications.

DO NOT wear contacts, jewelry, wrist watches or dark nail polish.

Wear a short sleeve top and loose fitting pants. Older, more comfortable non-precious clothing is recommended. Please do not wear flip flops or heels.

Bring someone with you to take you home and stay with you. You will be unable to drive for 24 hours after your surgery.

You will be at the office for 1-3 hours.

Time has been set aside especially for you. If you find you will not be able to make this appointment, notify the office 48 hours in advance.
